4. For the data on international reserves absolute variation is shown in the case of nonconvention variation.  
5. The final population as released in December 2001 (Census-2001). The final population includes the estimated population of Mao Mamam, Paomata and Pural subdivisions of Sonapat district of Manipal where census results were cancelled due to administrative and technical reasons although a population census was carried out in these subdivisions as per schedule. The estimated population of these three sub-divisions are: Mao Mamam: 6131; Paomata: 2780 and Pural: 3012. Population under the column 'Previous Data' refers to the 1991 Census data and includes projected population of Jammu & Kashmir state where 1991 Census could not be conducted due to disturbed condition prevailing there at the time of the census.
